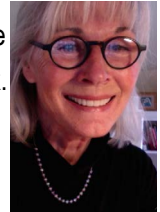

Then we'll get the group moving with some simple theatre warmups for those who wish to participate using body and voice. We'll distribute short, simple scenes from American theatre and learn about breaking scenes down, and move on to some participant read throughs. Then we'll reflect on our work. The second Saturday, we'll continue exercises and introductory work of this kind. We'll experience together, however briefly, the way actors do what they do."

Jennifer Mallowney is a professional studio photographer, and a street photographer with a passion for helping others see the beauty in a changed world with new eyes.

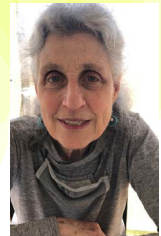
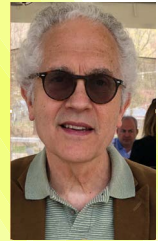
673507 - June 18 and 25 : "Discover Your Inner Songwriter with A Master Composer"
